Intra College Seminar and Quiz Competition at Shri Shivaji Science College-Nagpur

The Department of Physics at Shivaji Science College, Congress Nagar, Nagpur, organized an impressive Seminar and Quiz Competition on the 16th of October, 2023, with the support of the Physics Society. The event was inaugurated by Prof. Atul Bobde, and Dr. S.W.
