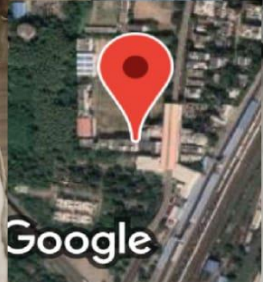
Mahatma Gandhi Death Anniversary

Mohandas Karamchand Gandhi was an Indian lawyer, anti-colonial nationalist and political ethicist who employed nonviolent resistance to lead the successful campaign for India's independence from British rule. He inspired movements for civil rights and freedom across the world. January 30th marks the death anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi “the father of the nation”, who was assassinated on this day by Nathuram Godse in 1948. Mahatma Gandhi is fondly called "Bapu".
