The National Foundation for Communal Harmony (NFCH) is conducting communal harmony campaign from 19 to 25 Nov 2021.



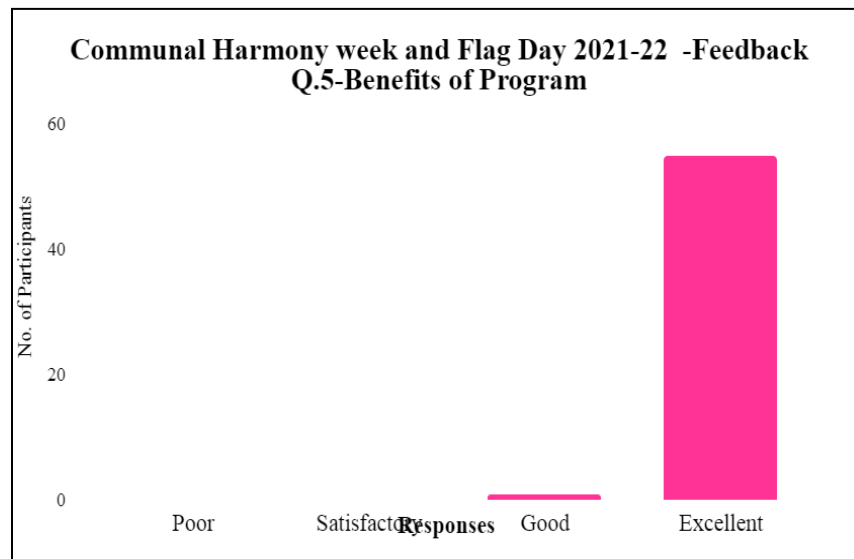
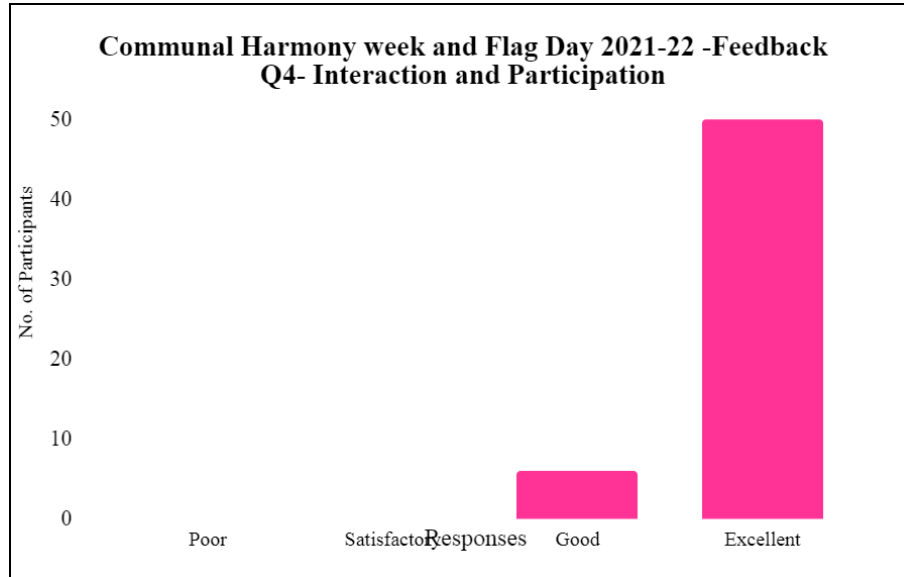
Feedback
