Report on Students' Induction Programme at Science College, Nagpur

DAY-1, date 4th October 2021 Address by Principal Dr M P Dhore




2. On 4 point scale, how do you rate this programme to get to know Ethos and Culture of our institute.




3. On 4 point scale, how do you rate relevance of Guest Speaker Psychologist Dr Raja Akash


- 1. The placement cell regularly organizes career guidance programs for all the students starting from first year.
