


During the induction program, have you been introduced to the following?




How satisfied you are with the overall arrangement and coordination of the induction program? 91 responses



Do you think the induction program will help/ has helped you to know your institute effectively? 91 responses




Rate the guest lecture included in the Induction programme




On 5 point scale, how do you rate $\,$ relevance of Guest Speaker Dr. Sudendra Gole (Day 1st).






On 5 point scale, how do you rate relevance of Guest Speaker Guest Speaker CP Hon'ble Amitesh Kumar IPS (Day 3rd).










On 5 point scale, how do you rate relevance of Guest Speaker Dr. Avinash Rode (Day 5th).








On 5 point scale, how do you rate relevance of Guest Speaker Dr. Satish Kadam (Day 5th). 91 responses










The information provided by various Heads of the Department was relevant.




On 5 point scale, how do you rate this programme to get to know Ethos and Culture of our institute.


On 5 point scale, how do you rate Sports.


