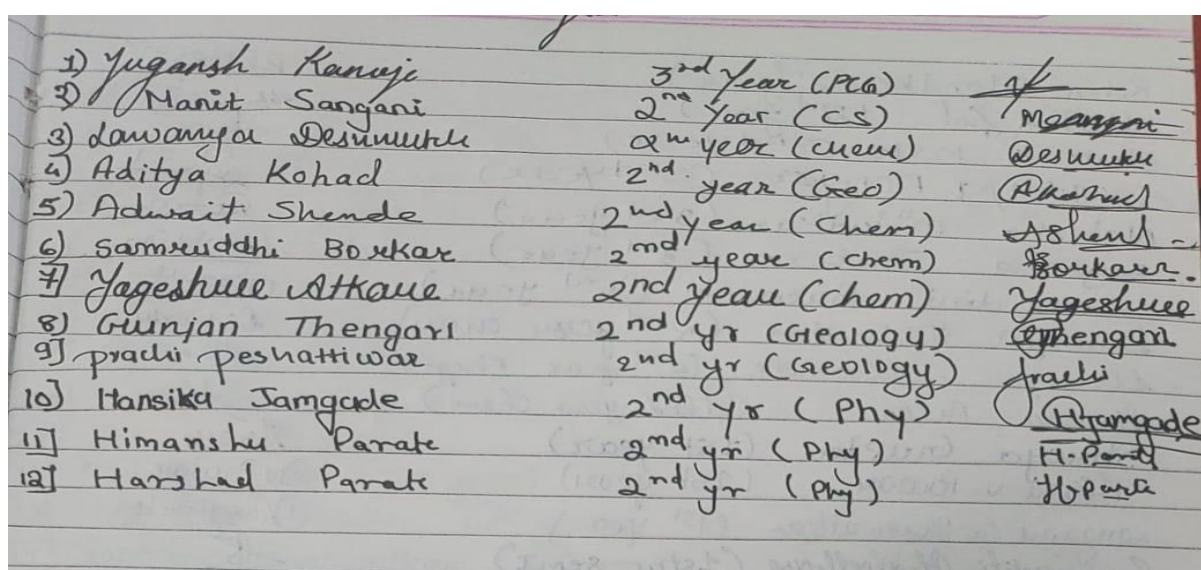

Feedback is typically collected from participants and key stakeholders through feedback forms and direct interaction. The analysis section summarizes key suggestions and areas for improvement.

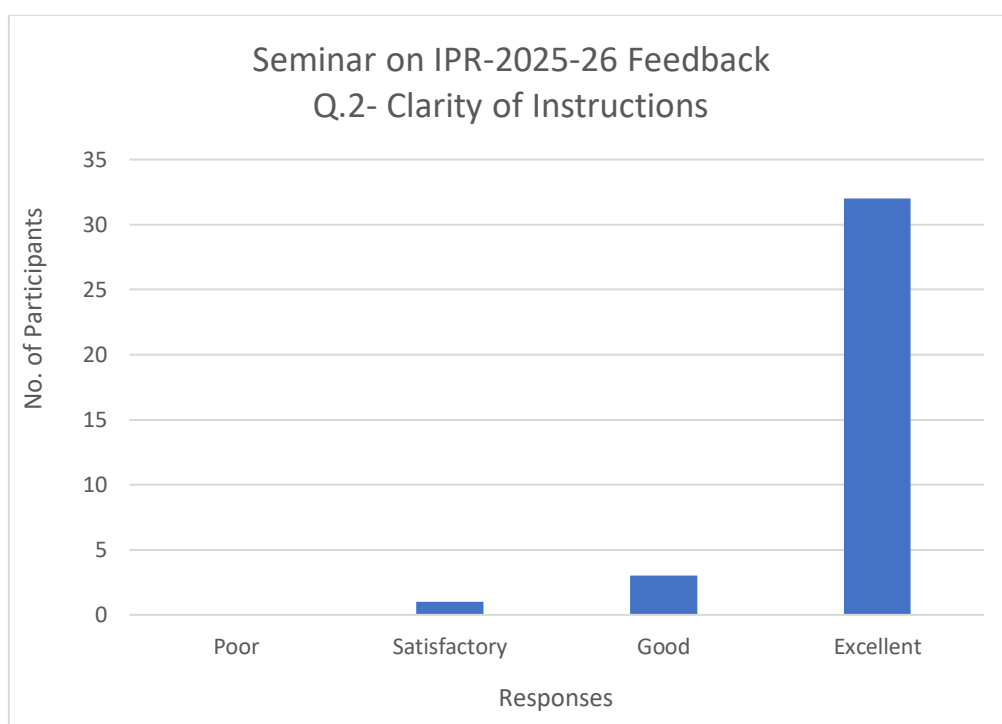
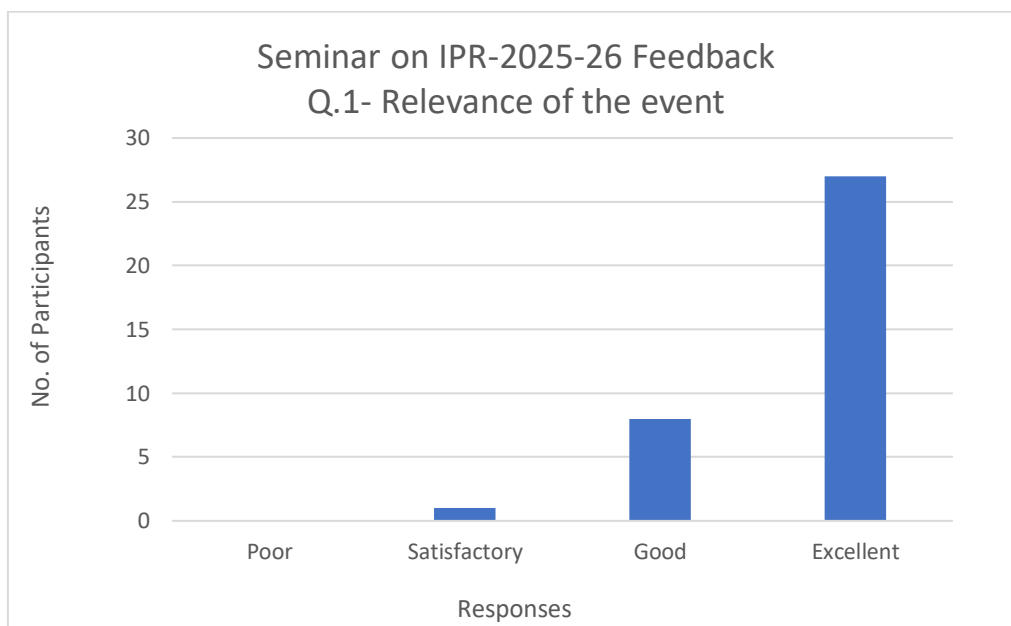
- **Positive feedback:**

 - The seminar was successful in explaining how to leverage IPR for startups and innovations.

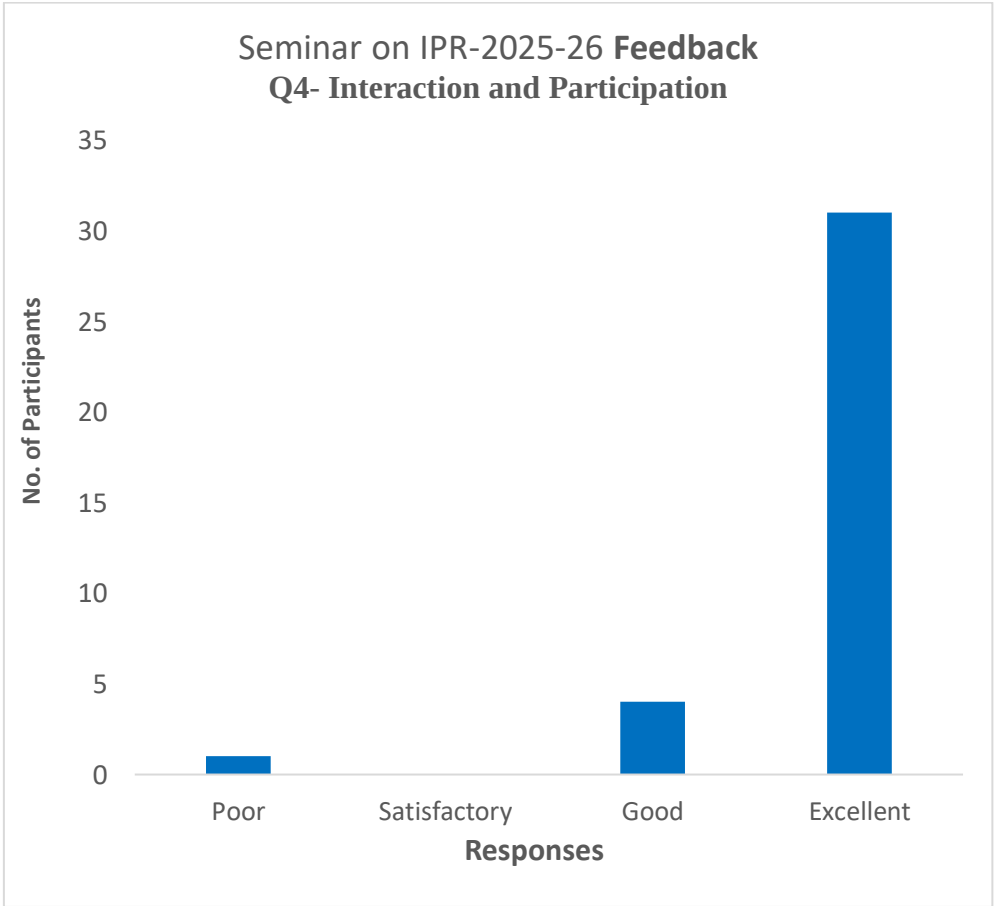
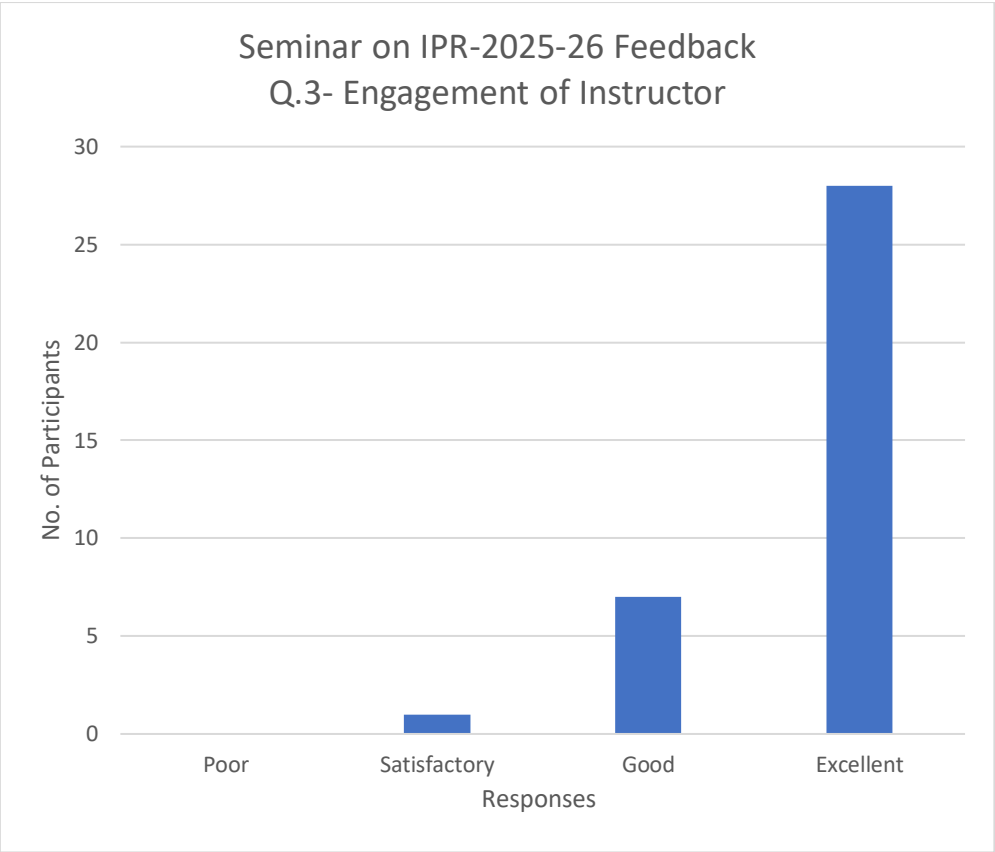


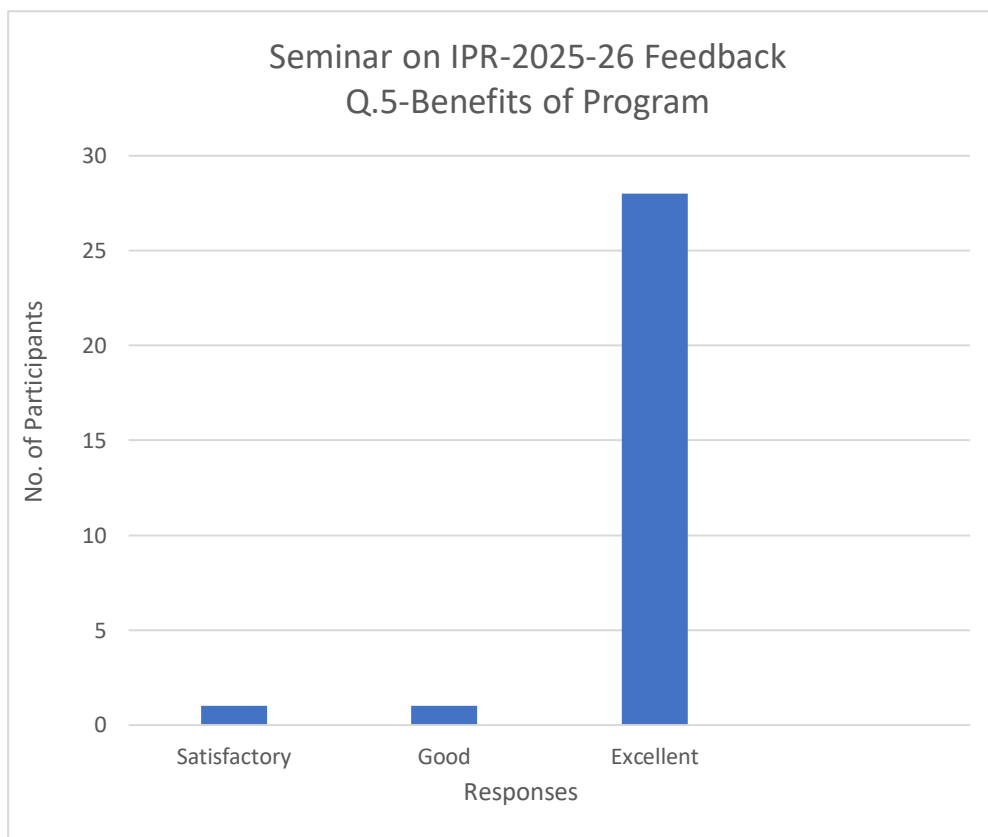
