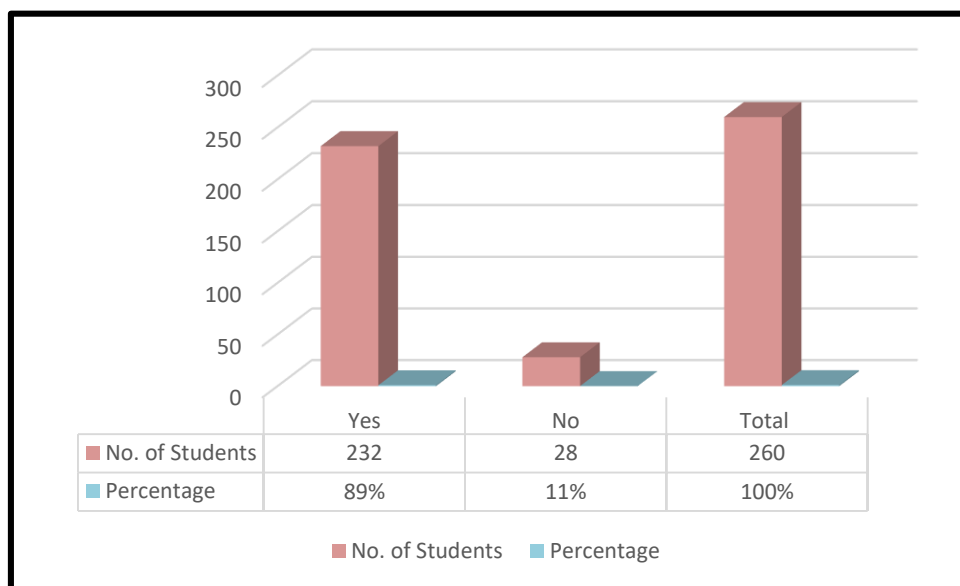
Q.3) How would you describe your level of interest during event?
