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Action Taken Report

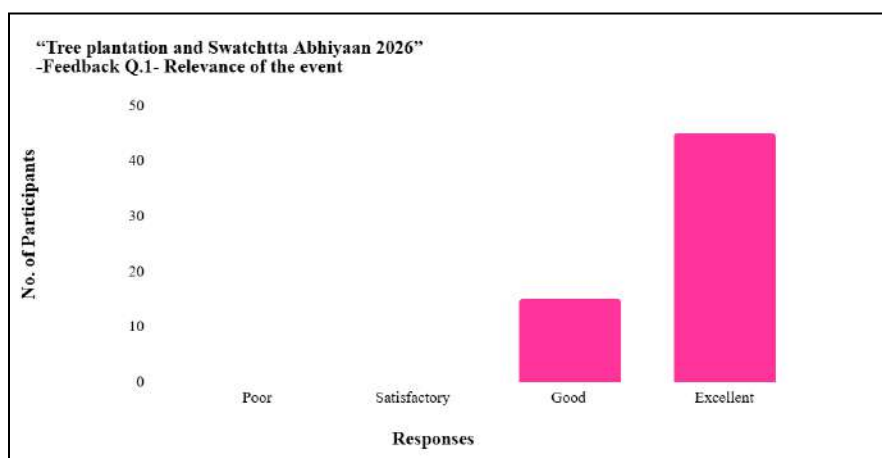
1. The identified areas of the college premises were cleaned and accumulated waste was removed.

7. The programme successfully created awareness among students regarding cleanliness, tree plantation, environmental protection, and their responsibility towards maintaining a clean and green campus.

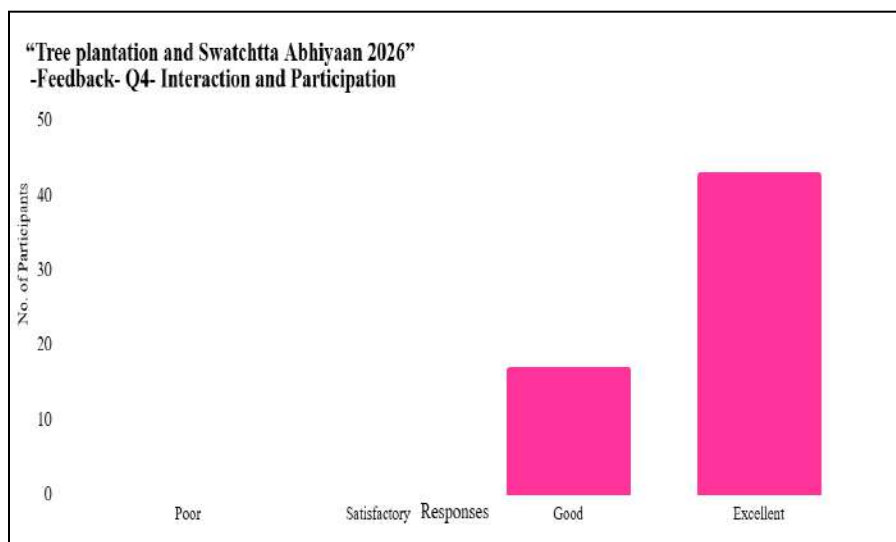
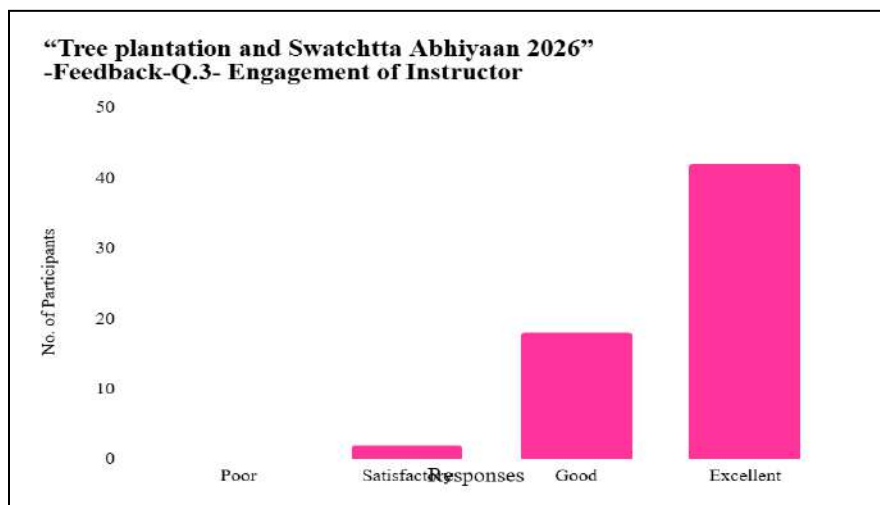
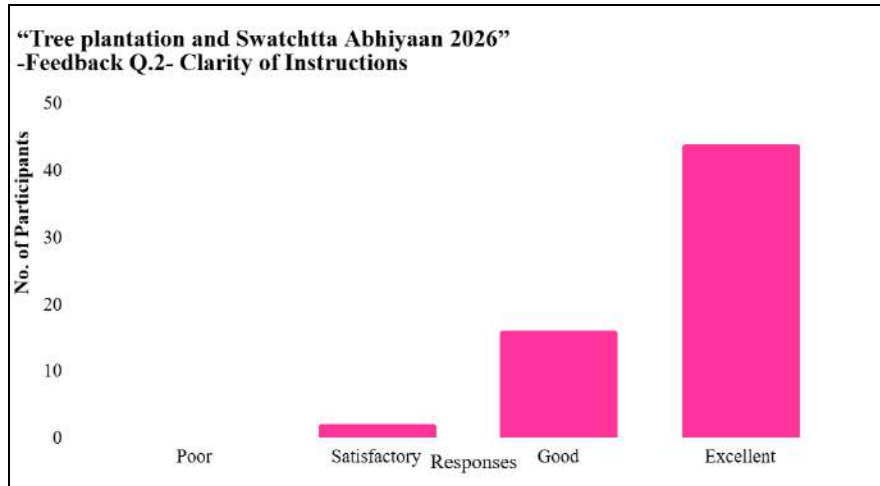
Outcome
