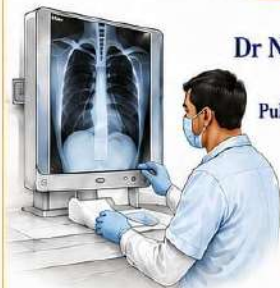

Medical Team

Number of Beneficiaries

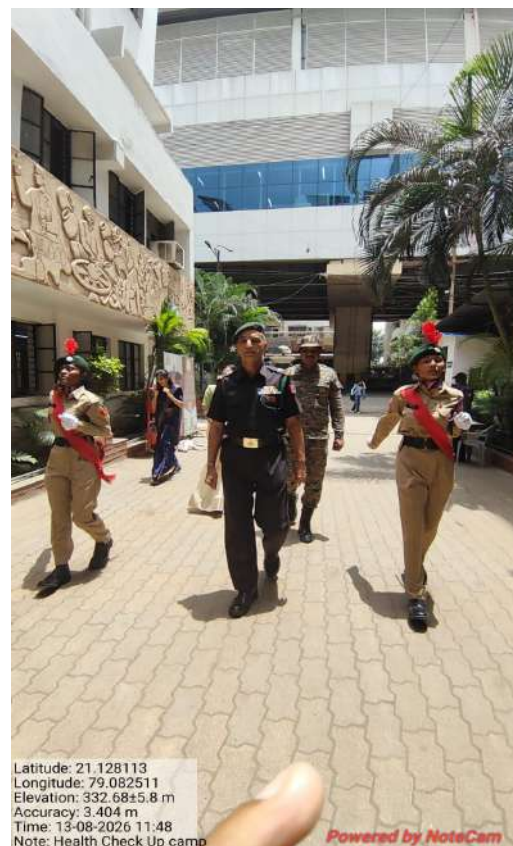
Conclusion

Action Taken

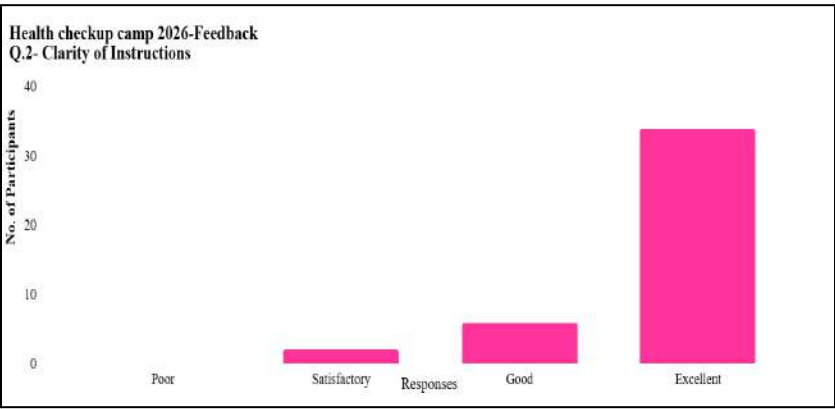
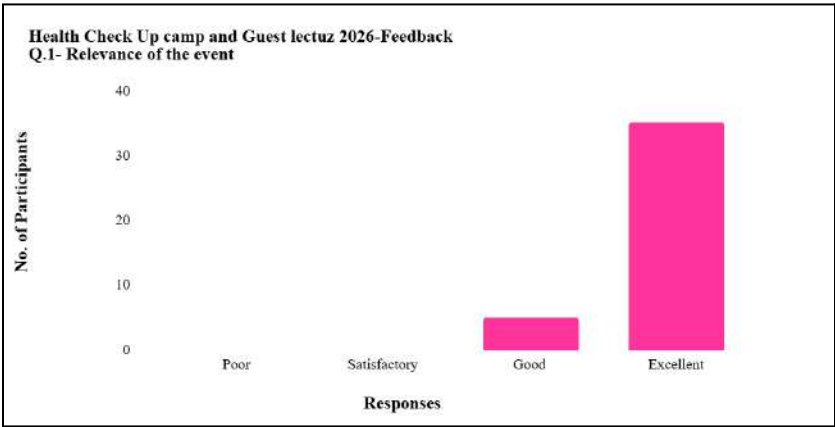
Outcome

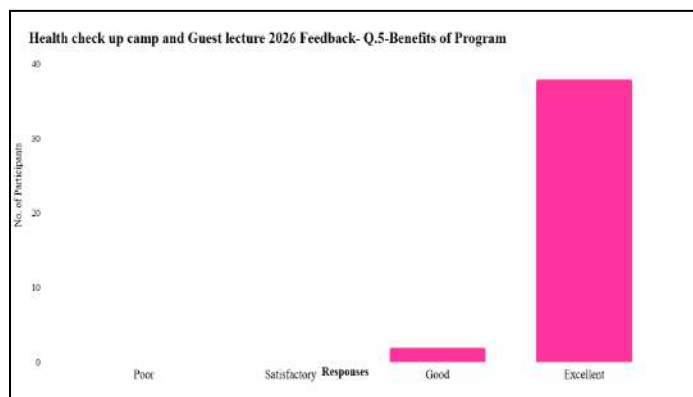
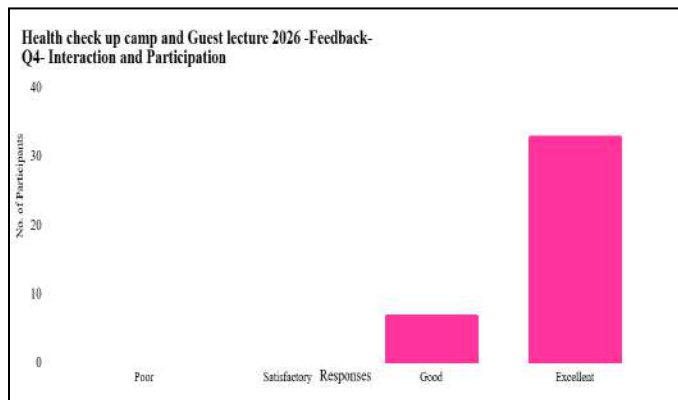
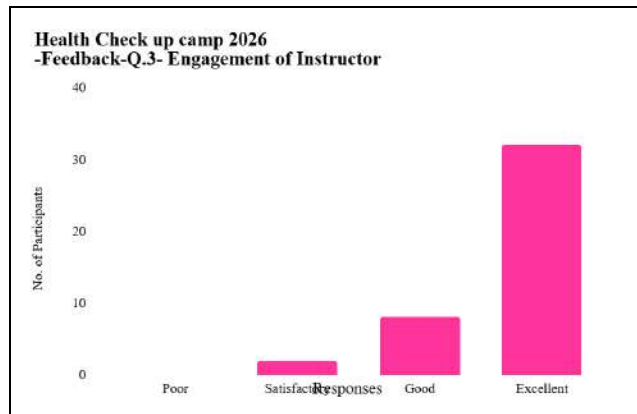
