Visit to Raman Science Centre & Planetarium
Date: 23/03/2026

An educational visit to Raman Science Centre and Planetarium, Nagpur was conducted on 23rd March 2026 for the students of B.Sc. First Year Biotechnology, Science College, Congress Nagar, Nagpur. The visit was accompanied by the faculty members Ms. Mayuri Bhad and Ms. Pallavi Bishwas. The students attended the World Water Day 2026 celebration organized by Raman Science Centre and Planetarium, Nagpur which aimed to promote awareness about water conservation, sustainable water management, and environmental responsibility through expert lectures and interactive scientific activities. The highlight of the program was an informative guest lecture delivered by Dr. Ashwini Baswaraj Mirajkar, Associate Professor, Water Resources Engineering, Department of Civil Engineering, VNIT, Nagpur. The lecture was based on the World Water Day 2026 theme, "Water and Gender", with the tagline "Where Water Flows, Equality Grows." Dr. Mirajkar discussed the growing water stress in India, highlighting challenges such as increasing population pressure, groundwater depletion, water pollution, and climate change. The session emphasized the importance of sustainable management of water resources and the need for collective efforts to conserve this vital natural resource.

The speaker highlighted government initiatives such as the “Jal Jeevan Mission and Jal Mahotsav”, emphasizing water conservation, equitable distribution, gender equality, and the role of citizens in sustainable water management. Traditional Indian water conservation systems, including kunds and stepwells, were also discussed as effective rainwater harvesting practices. After the lecture, students explored the interactive science galleries at Raman Science Centre, gaining hands-on experience with scientific exhibits. The visit concluded with a ‘Planetarium Show’ that enhanced their understanding of astronomy, the solar system, and space science while inspiring scientific curiosity.

Action Taken: The educational visit provided students with valuable exposure to contemporary issues related to water conservation and sustainable development while strengthening their scientific outlook. The participants actively attended the expert lecture, interacted with the resource person, and gained awareness of the environmental, social, and gender dimensions of water management. The faculty members, Ms. Mayuri Bhad and Ms. Pallavi Bishwas and ensured the smooth coordination and supervision of the students throughout the visit. 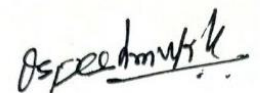
