Feedback Report (2018-2019)

Findings of feedback report session 2018-19

The college has the mechanism for analyzing student's feedback on institutional performance. Our college believes in imparting the highest quality of education and grooming the students to fit in the corporate world. In its never ending quest to continuously upgrade itself, our endeavor is to monitor the satisfaction level of students so that we can give better service to the future batches. In order to fulfill our endeavor we undertook surveys to carry out this study and observe areas where it can work to make our students more satisfied.

Approach and Methodology:

For the collection of data, structured questionnaires were used. These were distributed amongst the students for self-completion. The student was not required to write his or her name on the questionnaire. This helped in getting a high degree of honest and precise opinion from the students. Four questionnaires were prepared to get –

- 1. General feedback
- 2. Feedback on curriculum
- 3. Exit questionnaire for B.Sc. final year students.

The study highlights the overall satisfaction of students on

- > Course curriculum
- Co-curricular activities
- > Teaching methodology
- > Faculty performance
- > Evaluation methodology
- > Infrastructure
- Overall opinion about the college

The views and the feedback of these stake holders were collected through structured questionnaires which have been modified time to time.

Feedback on teachers' performance is collected from a representative sample of 10 students for every teacher. The 7 key parameters of this structured questionnaire, which would help to arrive at overall satisfaction, were placed for assigning marks out of 10 marks by students. Average scores are the students' satisfaction scores. These scores are then converted on four point scale.

In feedback of curriculum and for exit questionnaire frequencies of various options are considered to draw inferences about the students' satisfaction on every parameter.

The report is then submitted to the honourable Principal along with IQAC coordinator of the college for further action every year. They take the corrective measures at their end to address the concern raised by the sample of the survey.
