REPORT

The Safe Chemical Handling training is a comprehensive program designed to equip participants with the knowledge and skills to handle and manage chemicals safely in various work settings. Chemicals are integral part in chemistry laboratories, but mishandling them can result in accidents, injuries, and environmental hazards. Therefore to develop an understanding of the importance of safe chemical handling and to learn proper techniques for storing, transporting, and using chemicals, Three-day training Program on “**Handling of Chemicals and Equipments in Laboratory**” was conducted by Chemistry department Shivaji Science College ,Congress Nagar Nagpur, from 16th to 18th May, 2024 for nonteaching staff of the college. The program was jointly organized by IQAC of college which was a part of initiative to enhance the nonteaching staff competencies in acquaintance and proper handling of chemicals and equipments in the laboratories. Total **37 non teaching members** of the collage participated in this training program. Dhanshree Borikar, the invited speaker, emphasized that Academic science laboratories can be unsafe places for teaching and learning due to risks associated with biological, chemical, and physical hazards which requires all employees working in laboratory settings to

undergo safety training before they enter the lab. This is to ensure employees are cognizant of and know how to work with chemical hazards in the work area. According to the standard, safety training must take place at the time of the initial work assignment and prior to assignments involving new chemical exposure situations. Laboratory workers must be provided with information and training relevant to the physical and health hazards of chemicals present in their laboratory. She provided manual consisting of safety measures to the nonteaching staff. All non-teaching staff followed the instructions of Chemical safety and total 37 members successfully completed this program. The training program ended with vote of thanks.

Three-day training Program on **Handling of Chemicals and Equipments in Laboratory** was conducted at Shivaji Science College ,Congress Nagar Nagpur, from 16th to 18th May, 2024 for nonteaching staff of the college. 



Report
