1. Objectives:

Internal Academic Audit (IAA) is the best practice to improve the performance of students in the final examination. The main purpose of conducting an academic audit is to evaluate the performance of faculty and the department. This evaluation develops accountability, strength, and weakness of the department. The academic audit is conducted in the college by an internal expert committee and the committee submits the report containing the achievements of teachers and students.

2. The Context:

The performance of the faculty members and various departments is evaluated on the basis of the quality of teaching, research, administration, and curricular and extra-curricular activities.

- IQAC has developed a format of Internal Academic Audit (IAA) on the basis of seven criteria of NAAC.
- Academic audit being conducted at the end of the Session. The College provides the facilities to the faculty members and students to gain knowledge and update skills by encouraging them to participate in seminars, conferences, workshops, research programs, etc., and also to work on live projects.

3. The Practice:

The college established Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) in the year 2004 to impart quality education as per the guidelines of the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC).
