Prof. Li Yaogang has intensive interest in education evaluation. He has moved to the field since he worked as the Vice Dean for the Department of Human Resources of Donghua University in May, 2006, and he has conducted many education evaluation projects for institutions and programs. Especially he is very experienced in the evaluation of the academic qualification of teachers in HEIs.

## 2. *Jing Tian*

Ph.D. Lecturer of Hangzhou Dianzi University, Chinese Academy of Science and Education Evaluation. Jing Tian gets doctoral degree in Beijing Normal University, majors in Comparative Education. Jing Tian was a visiting doctoral student of University of Wisconsin-Madison in 2016-2017. Jing Tian's research focuses on comparative higher education, especially higher education internationalization and higher education evaluation. 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### 3. *Jasmina Havranek*



Professor, PhD was born in Zagreb, where she finished primary school and gymnasium, graduated and obtained a doctorate at the Faculty of Agriculture, University of Zagreb. In 2001 she was elected tenured full professor at the same University.

In the period 2003 – 2005, Prof. Havranek was a President of the National Council for Higher Education of the Republic of Croatia, and in 2007 was appointed a Head of

the Croatian Agency for Science and Higher Education (ASHE).

In 2010, during her mandate, ASHE received important international recognition: the European Regional Economic Forum recognised it as an example of good practice in the implementation of quality assurance in higher education and science.

In the same year the Agency gained full [ENQA](#) (European Association for Quality Assurance in Higher Education) membership, and it was included on the European Quality Assurance Register for Higher Education ([EQAR](#)). For most of her professional life, Prof. Havranek has been promoting importance of quality standards and culture and raising awareness about the importance and improvement of public policies in science and higher education.

Director of Croatian Agency for Science and Higher Education

4. *Emita Blagdan* (born 1976) is Assistant Director of Croatian Agency for Science and Higher Education (ASHE). She graduated in Philosophy and Croatian Literature at the University of Zagreb and received postgraduate degree (M.Phil.) in the field of EU policy at the Faculty of Political Science

at the University of Zagreb. Currently she is finishing doctoral study at the University of Zagreb, Faculty of Philosophy. She has been a contributor to the ENIC-NARIC network for many years in different topics within scope of higher education. She is involved in different activities regarding recognition of foreign HE qualifications, Croatian system of external quality assurance in higher education and science, recognition of prior learning, qualifications networks. She was and still is a member of different national expert groups responsible for developing policy and legal frameworks for quality assurance in higher education and science, recognition of foreign higher education qualifications, etc. She is involved in a number of activities organised by various European and international stakeholders. Emita has 13 years of experience working with ASHE, has participated in a number of international projects as a project manager, or national expert on the topics related to joint study programmes, recognition of foreign qualifications, RPL, external QA procedures, QF's etc. Assistant Director of Croatian Agency for Science and Higher Education.

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APQN Quality Awards were initiated in 2013 which aimed to mark decennial celebrations of APQN. As feedback to APQN Quality Awards has been very encouraging, APQN Board decided that awards would continue every year but some of the Award themes may change accordingly.

APQN would encourage members which have been doing much more outstanding work individually, institutionally, nationally as well as internationally to submit applications for Quality Awards. Quality Award is not a competition as members vary in different countries and have specific contexts and mandates. Hence, APQN Quality Award is intended to identify and distinguish extraordinary or prominent QA contributions and good practices that have potential of replications in the Asia-Pacific area. APQN Criteria and Chiba principles will be generally applied to all categories as selection criteria.

The 2014 APQN Quality Award categories are as follows:

**i. APQN's Best/Model Internal QA Award**

This award is set up for institutional members only. The institutional members who have committed to quality assurance mechanism and quality culture building are encouraged to apply for this award so as to make much wider circulation about their best or model IQA practices and experiences.

**ii. APQN Quality Champions Award**

This award is set up for individuals who have made outstanding contributions in promoting quality and excellence of higher education and recognized nationally and internationally in his research achievements or leadership of QA activities.

**iii. International cooperation in QA**

This award is open to full and intermediate APQN members. Those members who have kept pace with the regional and international trend in QA of higher education as well as cross-border higher education and have taken specific actions to put it into practice with the integration of national QA successfully would be considered for this award.

**iv. Training and support of reviewers**

This award is open to all categories of APQN members which is one-off award. Those members who have made prominent contributions in training and support of reviewers locally and/or regionally and have developed sound and effective material kit of training would be nominated.

Only CEOs of full and intermediate members of APQN and Board members of APQN can send nominations for themselves or other APQN members. The presidents of institutional members could send nominations for themselves or other APQN institutional members

A panel of three eminent international experts appointed by APQN Board will review all the nominations and make final decision on Quality Awards. No appeal will be provided as this is a peer review or judgment. Up to two awards under each category will be given to candidate nominees.

Generally APQN member will not be considered for award in same category for two consecutive years.

APQN Quality Award will be presented during APQN Annual conference to be held during 7-8 March 2014 in Hanoi, Vietnam. Attractive mementoes and certificates will be awarded to the winners. In addition, award winners will be invited to present and share their good practices in the APQN annual conference with other members as well.
